
A NEW OPTION FOR ACUTE PAIN CONTROL

- Will you or a loved one be prescribed an opioid in the future? (Oral, Orthopaedic, or General Surgery, etc.)
- Ask if you are a candidate for the PainPack Protocol.



- This protocol maximizes non-opioid medication at prescription doses and allows for the opioid to be an option rather than an obligation.
- To best control your pain, take Tylenol 1000 mg and Ibuprofen 800 mg every 6-8 hours each day.
- Make sure to wait 1-2 hours between the Tylenol and Ibuprofen.
- The Oxycodone 5 mg (an opioid, aka "heroin in a pill") is to be used only for pain that is not relieved by the Tylenol & Ibuprofen. (We recommend using the Oxycodone in 1/2 pill increments.)






To best control your pain, take the Tylenol® and Ibuprofen every 6-8 hours each day.

Make sure to wait 1-2 hours between the Tylenol® and **Ibuprofen**.

The Oxycodone (opioid) is to be used only for pain not relieved by the schedule below:







WARNING Oxycodone

side effects include:

- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Constipation
- Headache
- Legal Impairment
- Risk of Addiction

If you need more pain relief than the routine shown at left, consider taking at **any** time:

Oxycodone

(½-2 pills every 4-6 hours)

Recommended to start with ½ pill and only take more if needed.



Continue to take the Tylenol® and Ibuprofen every 6-8 hours each day.

Make sure to wait 1-2 hours between the Tylenol® and Ibuprofen.

The Oxycodone (opioid) is to be used only for pain not relieved by the schedule below:

Tylenol®

(2 pills, 500 mg each)

Wait 1 - 2 hours

Ibuprofen (Motrin[®], Advil[®]) (1 pill, 800 mg)



Take every 6-8 hours with food.

Goal is to take 3 doses of each every day.

For safety and better pain control, use the chart below to track when you take your medicines.

Bring this sheet to your follow-up appointment.

WARNING Oxycodone

(aka Narcotic Pain Medicine, 'Heroin in a Pill') is an opioid and has potential risk of ADDICTION.

If you need more pain relief than the routine shown at left, consider taking at **any** time:

Oxycodone

(½-2 pills every 4-6 hours)

Recommended to start with ½ pill and only take more if needed.
